PARENT INVOLVEMENT IN FEDERAL PROGRAMS/TITLE I

Meade School Board recognizes the importance of parental involvement with Federal Programs/Title I and operations of the public school. By working together, the quality of the educational programs will improve.

To foster mutual respect and confidence between parents and the board, an atmosphere of openness and honesty will prevail. The Board will encourage parents and representatives to express ideas, concerns and judgments about the schools to the school administration, to staff appointed advisory bodies and to the Board. It will be the Board's responsibility to provide the public with accurate and complete information on the schools and Board's activities.

Parents' Advisory Committees

The Board recognizes that one of the best methods to maintain good communications with parents, and to establish sound public relations, is through temporary parent Advisory Committees.

These committees will be appointed when needed for a specific time and purpose, and will be under the supervisory control of the Superintendent or his/her designee. He/she will report to the Board on its membership, functions, progress and final report.

Parental Involvement Guidelines developed through this process will be maintained on file in the Special Services Department.
