Gym will be sanitized with fogger after each practice/event.

Travel Rubric – indicators to be looked at when making the decision to travel to another school for a contest

- Does the school have any confirmed/active cases of Covid-19?
- Has the team we are going to play had anyone diagnosed with Covid-19 or quarantined due to close contact?
- Has there been a spike of confirmed cases in the community that we are traveling too?
 - If our traveling party is staying overnight this could be a factor.
- Does SBHS have any confirmed cases of Covid-19?
- Has any of the prospective traveling party been confirmed with Covid-19 or quarantined due to close contact?
- Has there been a spike in the number of confirmed/active cases in the Meade School District?

Suspending Practice –

- Does the team/group have a person with a confirmed case?
- How many members of the group has the infected person been in close contact with up to 48 hours prior to being confirmed?
 - Close Contact as defined by the CDC – Within 6ft; Face to Face; more than 15 minutes

Meal protocols –

- The Meade School District Activities office will support sack lunches for teams as meals either in the building (SBHS) or on bus trips.
- If team meals are organized outside of the team, coaches cannot promote the event nor can they attend the event.

- Meals for groups traveling will either be pre-made meals or carry out that will be eaten on the bus.
 - Teams will not eat a sit down meal at any restaurants.
- It is suggested to communicate the order prior to going to the food place so that the students can just walk through the establishment pick up their food, pay and return to the bus.
 - To accomplish this the order:

- May be called in
 - Can be delivered by the bus driver after dropping the team off.
 - A coach should then call when the game is done so the food is ready when the bus arrives to pick it up

- We will not stop when traveling to or coming home from a school within the black hills area.
 - If you and your team are traveling in a suburban or the Scooper bus you may stop at a gas station. Masks should be worn when entering such an establishment.
