EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

The superintendent shall be responsible for implementing appropriate emergency procedures for preparedness in case of fire, civil emergency and natural disaster.

The superintendent may close the District schools, alter selected bus routes, or dismiss school early when hazardous weather or other emergencies threaten the health or safety of students and personnel. Parents will be informed of these actions on radio stations KBHB, KRCS, KTOQ, KIMM, KGGG, KFXS, KOUT, KKLS, KMKK, KDDX, KZZI, KSQY, and KDSJ, and on television stations KOTA, KEVN, and KNBN. If school is closed during the day and buses cannot run, parents are responsible for making arrangements for their children.
