June has begun with a few changes. The department has had the first meeting with the custodial department to begin the transition to moving them in the department. The department has been creating a power point presentation to help to communicate to the Board as projects are progressing. Rasmussen and Tem-Tech will begin to order and secure IAQ/HVAC equipment for the high school. We are also preparing to start to install LED lighting in the facility. The rear door and foyer that lead to the Ag. Building will be built and installed in July. The 3<sup>rd</sup> of four roof sections is due to be installed.

At Sturgis Elementary we had damage due to the hail. The EIFS has been repaired and we are awaiting the for reroofing the Bear Butte section. The Bear Butte section of the building is going to be upgraded with new VAV's and the removal of antiquated air valves. The old nurses and library are to receive new carpet.

The Business Building will receive two new doors and windows at the rear of the building.

SWMS has the south parking lot slated to be installed. The Grunwald public restrooms are also being updated to help with activities in gym. SWMS is also receiving LED fixtures interior and exterior to help with safety and efficiency.

The upstairs lighting in most of the upstairs at PVE has been upgraded to LEDS. The main floor classrooms are next in line.

Stagebarn is doing well. We will be installing a fence around the track to help with security.

Elm Springs is to have new playground equipment installed. Opal is going to have the well reinstated and checked to see what the district needs to do to provide safe drinking water to the facility. CRMS is still in the process of establishing a playground. All schools are to be checked for needed gravel.

Whitewood will receive a new entrance door leading to the playground.

The department has all the gym floors completed or scheduled to be finished. The custodial departments have worked extremely hard through this pandemic and in most instances are back to a "normal" summer cleaning schedule.
