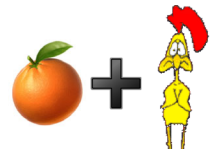

Davis-Bahcall Scholars: Join a three-week, fully supported summer program exploring the world of modern scientific research at leading laboratories and universities. Application deadline is January 21, 2022. Information on the SBHS website.

85th Annual The American Legion Department of South Dakota 2022 High School Oratorical Scholarship Program: Young orators earn some of the most generous college scholarships available to high school students. The overall national contest winner gets a \$25,000 scholarship. Second place takes home \$22,500, and third gets \$20,000. Each department (state) winner who is certified into and participates in the national contest's first round receives a \$2,000 scholarship. Those who advance past the first round receive an additional \$2,000 scholarship. The American Legion's National Organization awards the scholarships, which can be used at any college or university in the United States. Contest links can be found on the SBHS website.
